




CHECKING DONE NEAR THE COLLEGE GATES AS A PRECAUTIONARY MEASURE


The College makes sure each and every person entering the college campus is checked for temperature and is sanitised. Social distancing is also strictly followed by the college.

III YEAR STUDENTS ATTENDING CLASSES IN COLLEGE WITH NECESSARY PRECAUTIONS






WEBINAR CONDUCTED BY THE HEALTH CLUB ON COVID 19
