SEMINAR ON USAGE OF ENGLISH

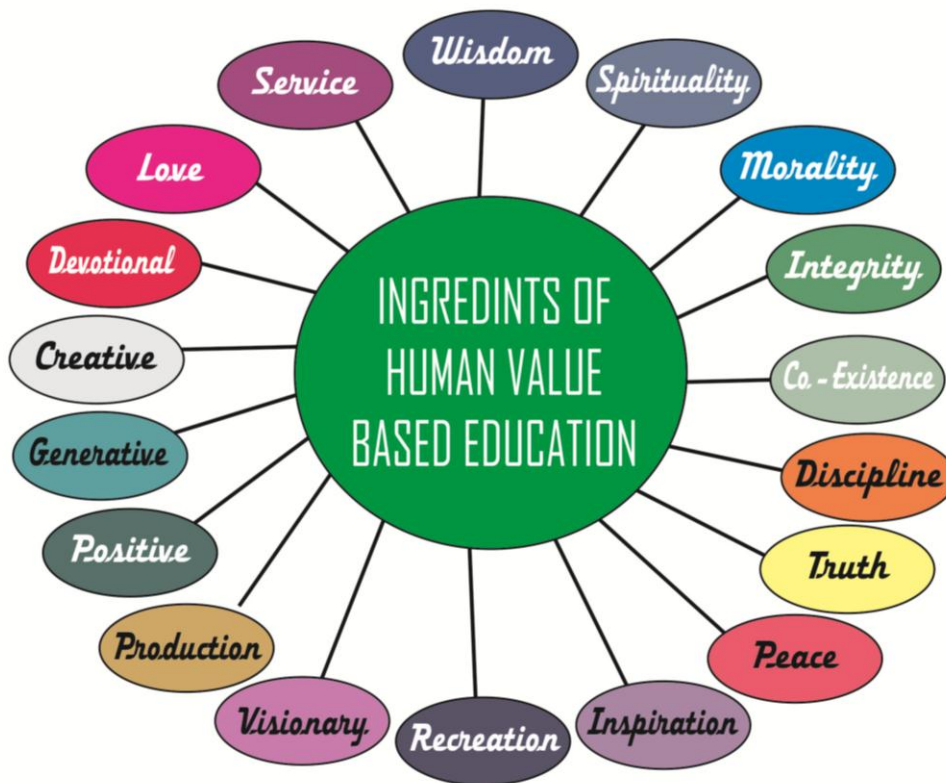

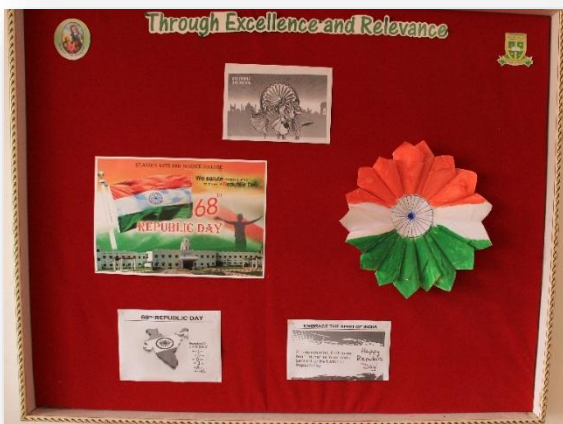
REPUBLIC DAY CELEBRATION

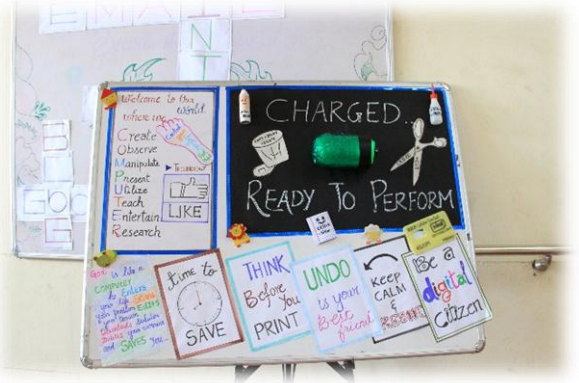
REPORT ON COMPUTER DEPARTMENT ASSOCIATION – WARTECH 2017
