REXONA CONFIDENCE ACADEMY

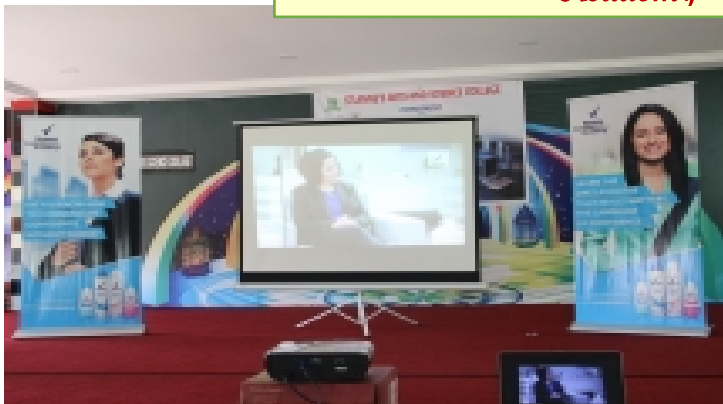

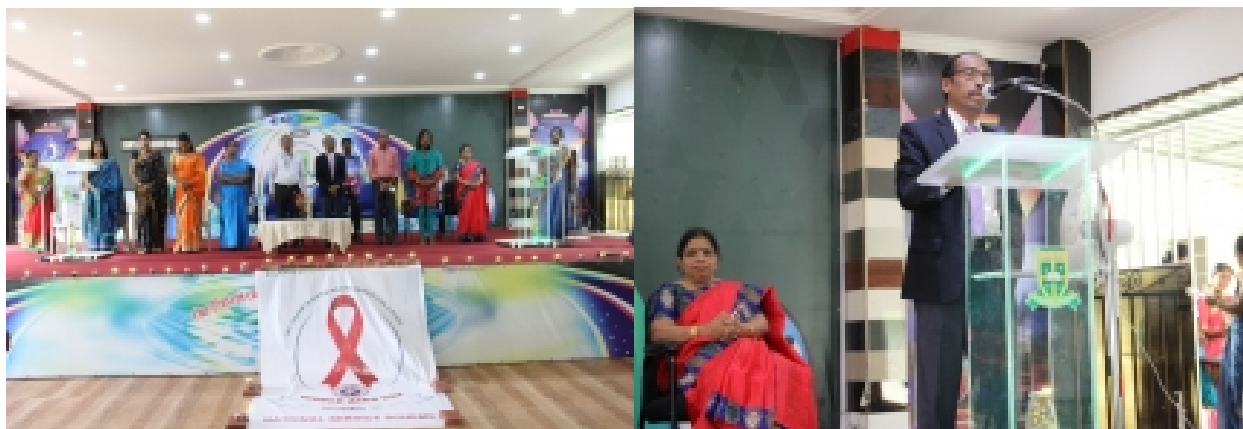

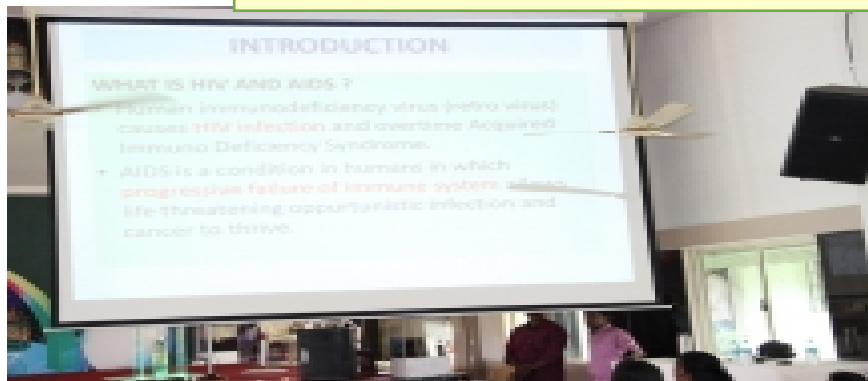


Program on AIDS Awareness

Slideshow regarding HIV by Dr. Manimegalai

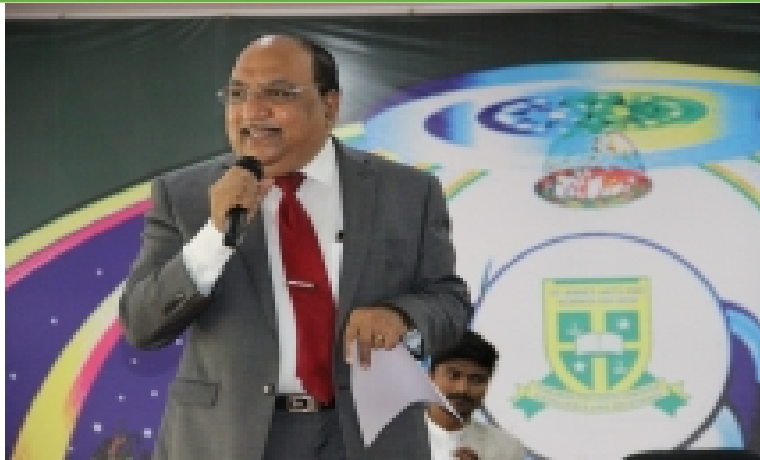


PLACEMENT TRAINING PROGRAM

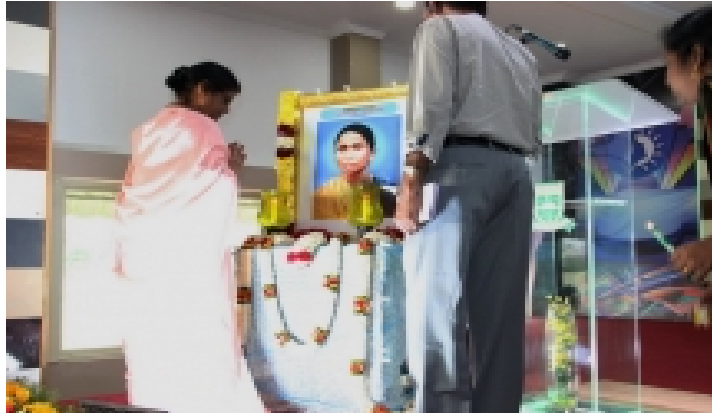
FOUNDRESS DAY, CHRISTMAS CELEBRATION, MOTHER'S ALUMNI MEET
