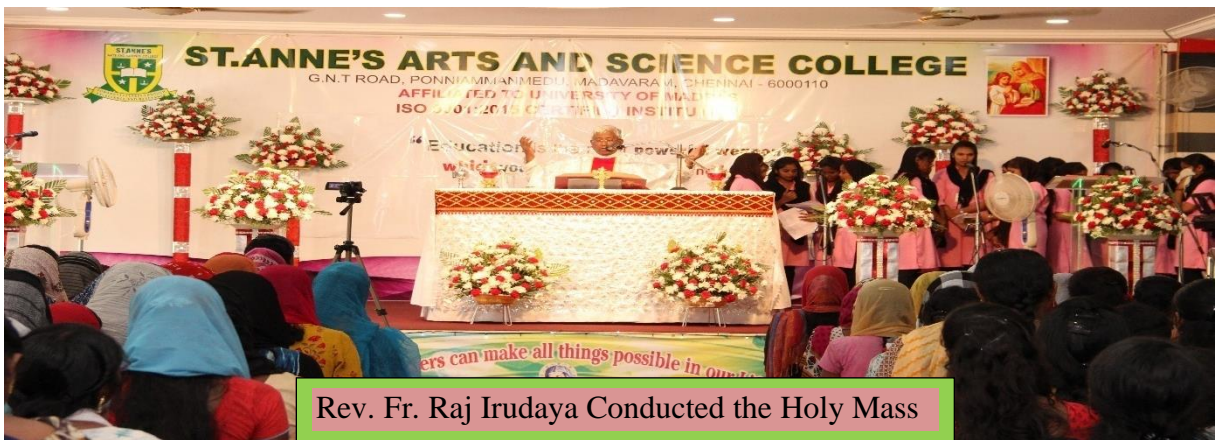


St. Anne's Feast (25/07/2019)

The programme concluded with a feedback session from students and a vote of thanks by coordinator.

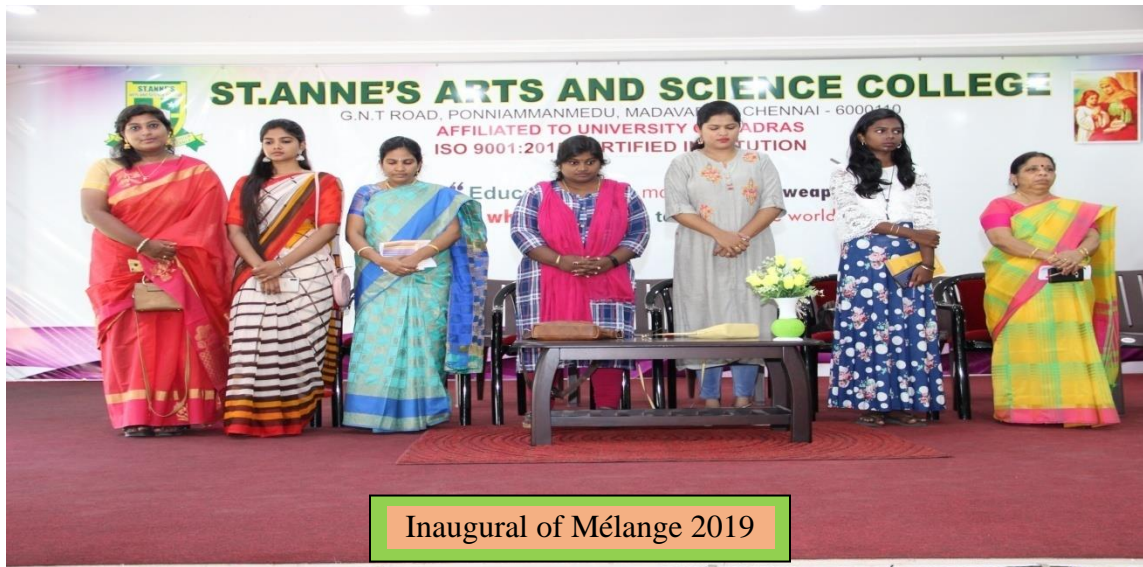


Melange – A Cultural Fête **10/08/2019**

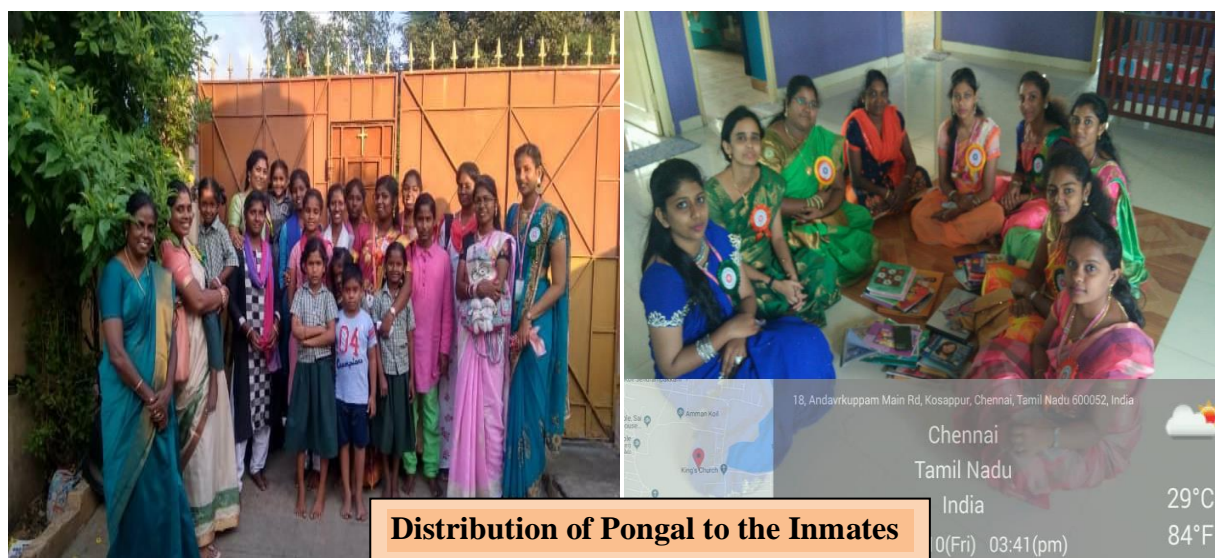

21/01/2020

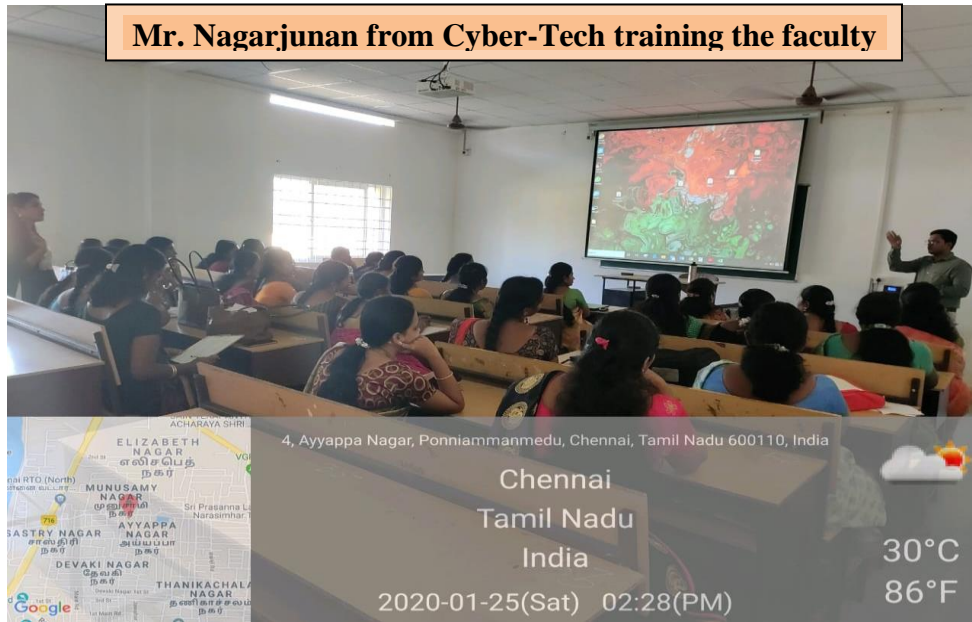

Sparsh Leprosy Awareness Campaign

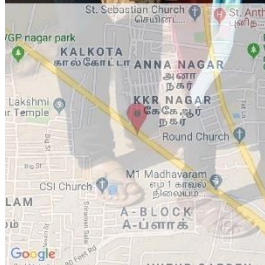
25/01/2020, 05/02/2020

Awareness Program on Corona Virus 13/02/2020

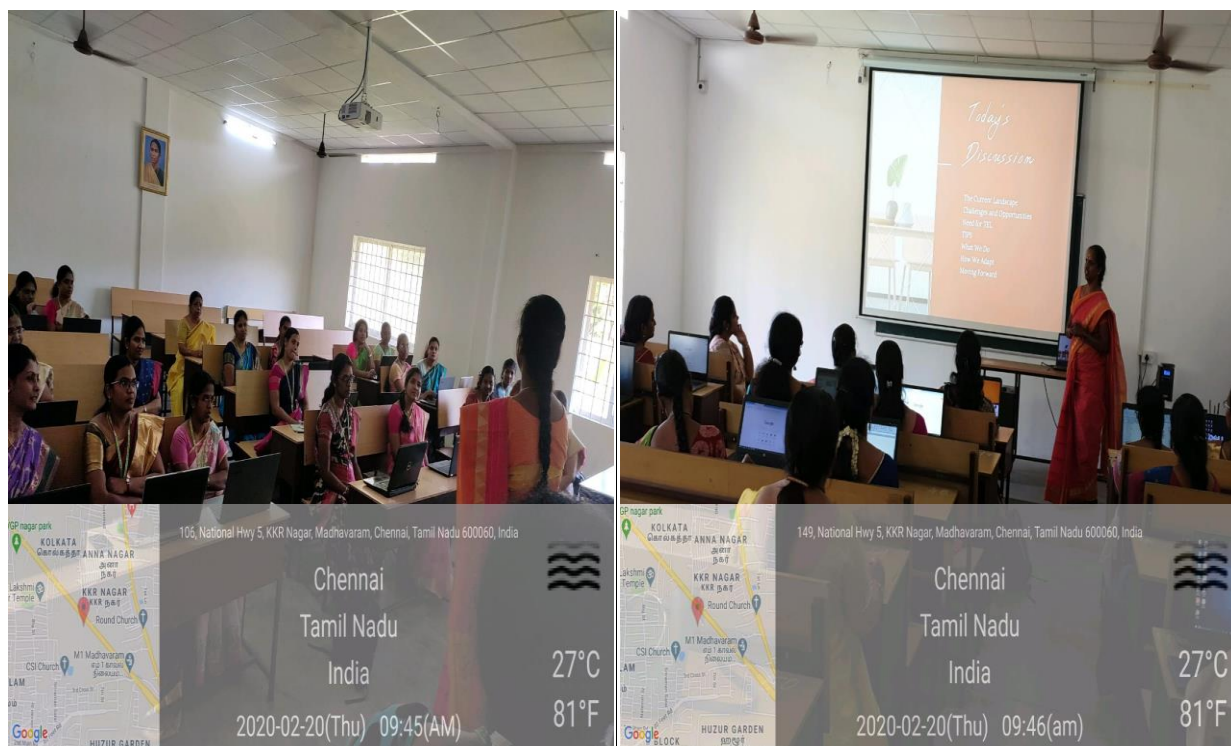

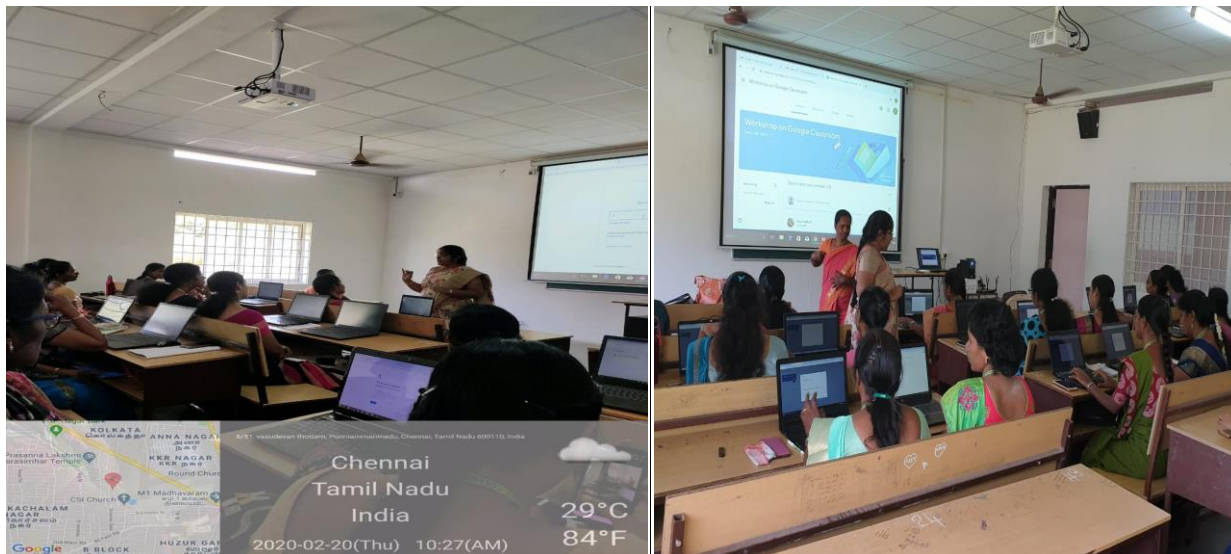
Faculty Development Program on Technology Enabled Teaching 20/02/2020

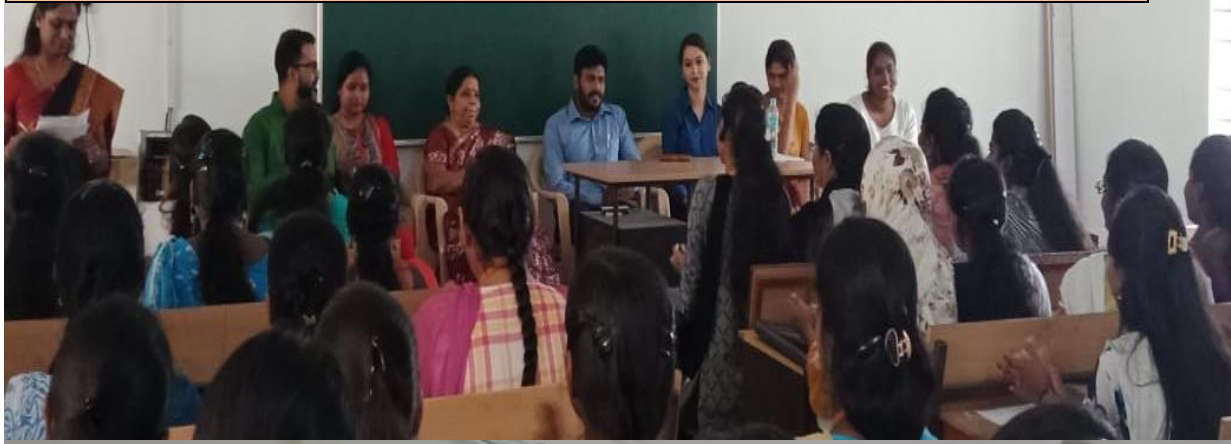
Placement Drive
