FACULTY DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM ON INNOVATION AND TEACHING

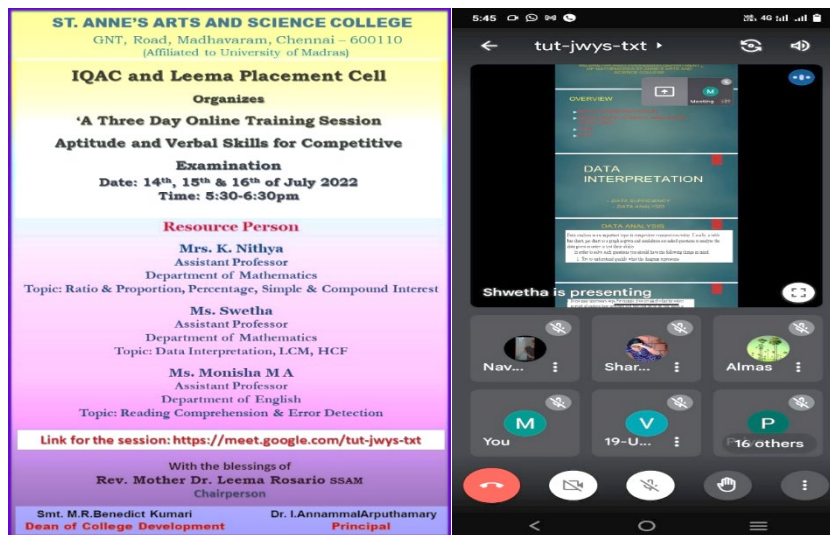

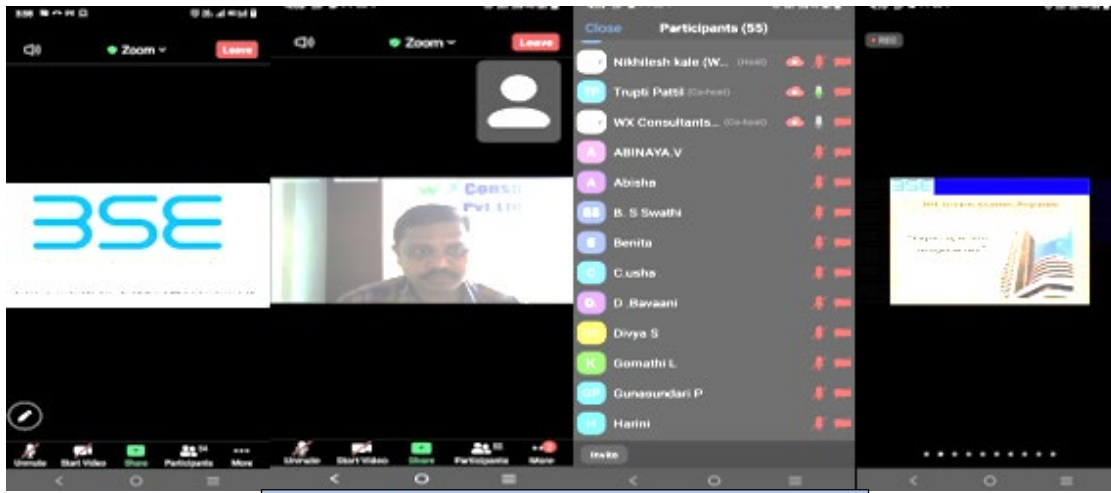

NATIONAL HANDLOOM DAY

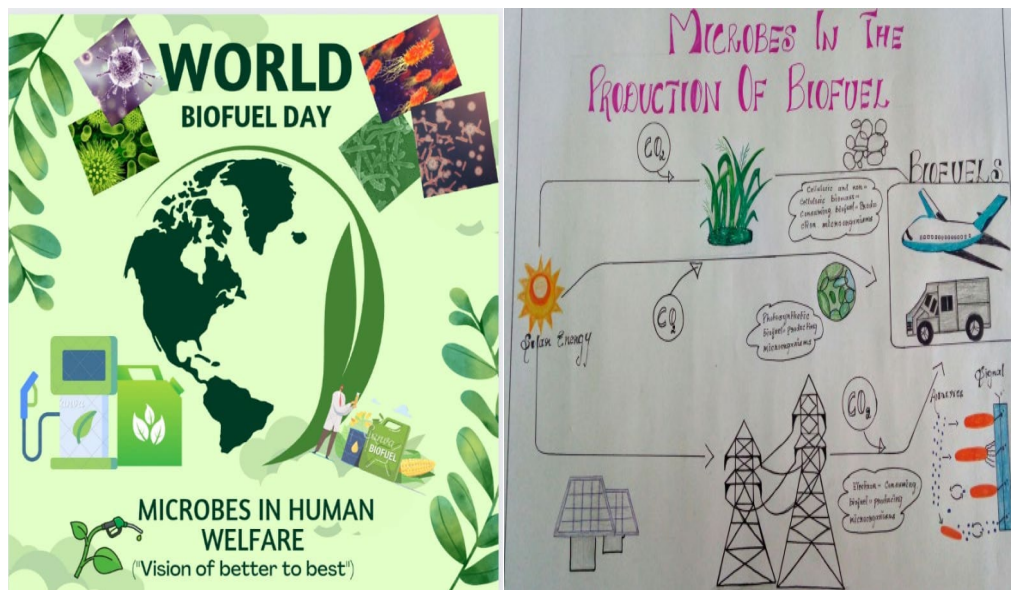

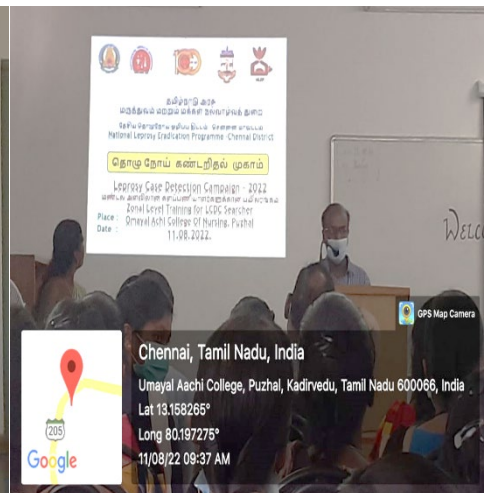

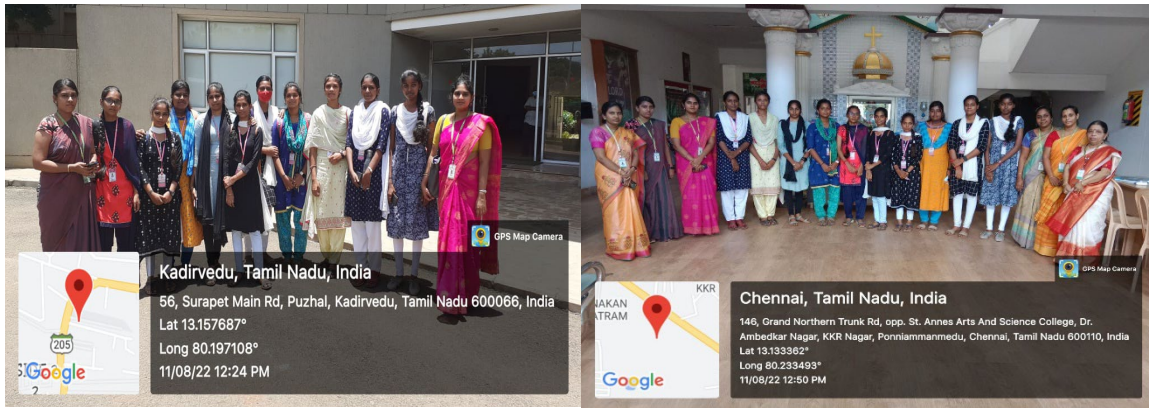


TRAINING PROGRAMME ON LEPROSY CASE DETECTION

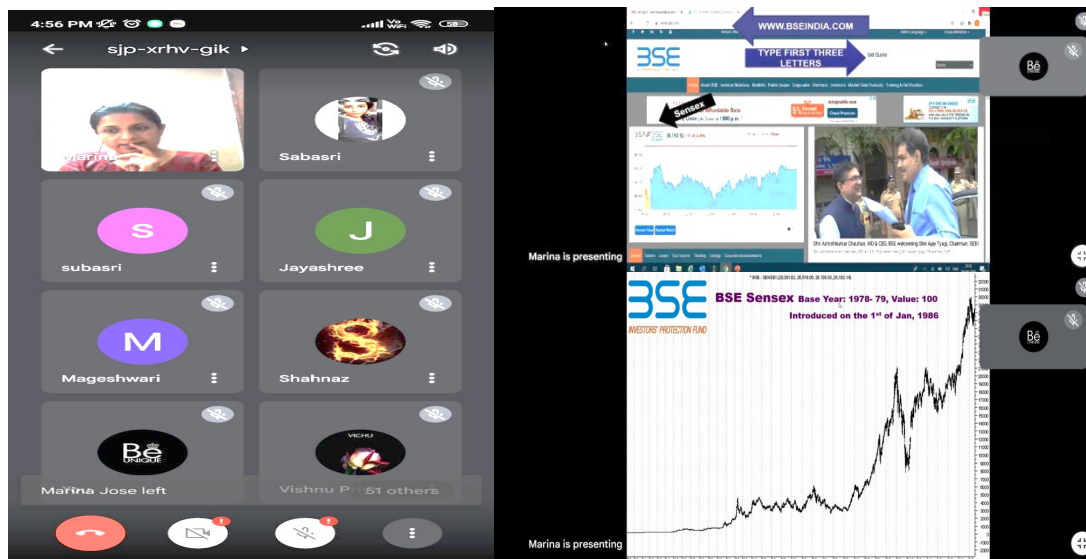

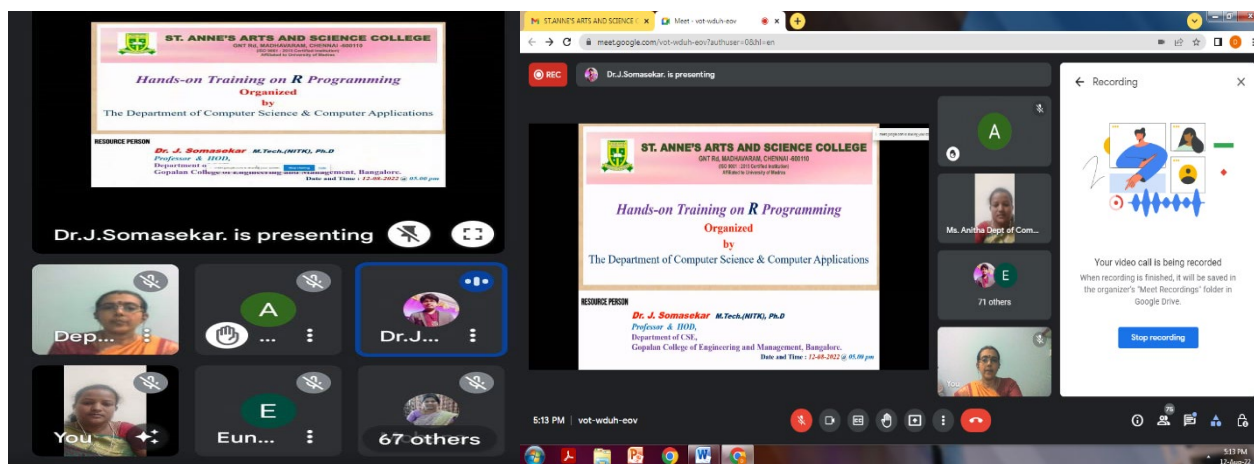


INDEPENDENCE DAY CELEBRATIONS

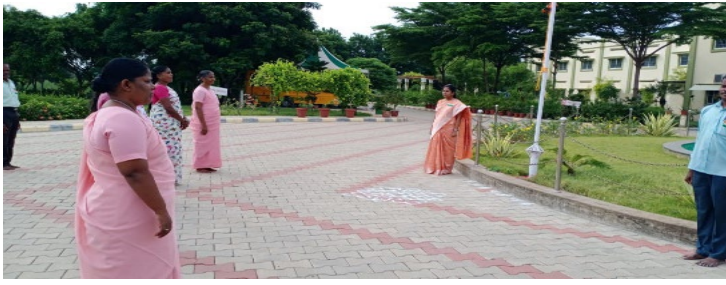

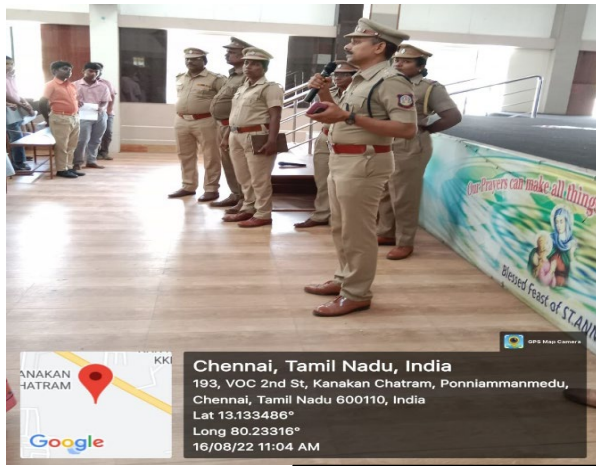

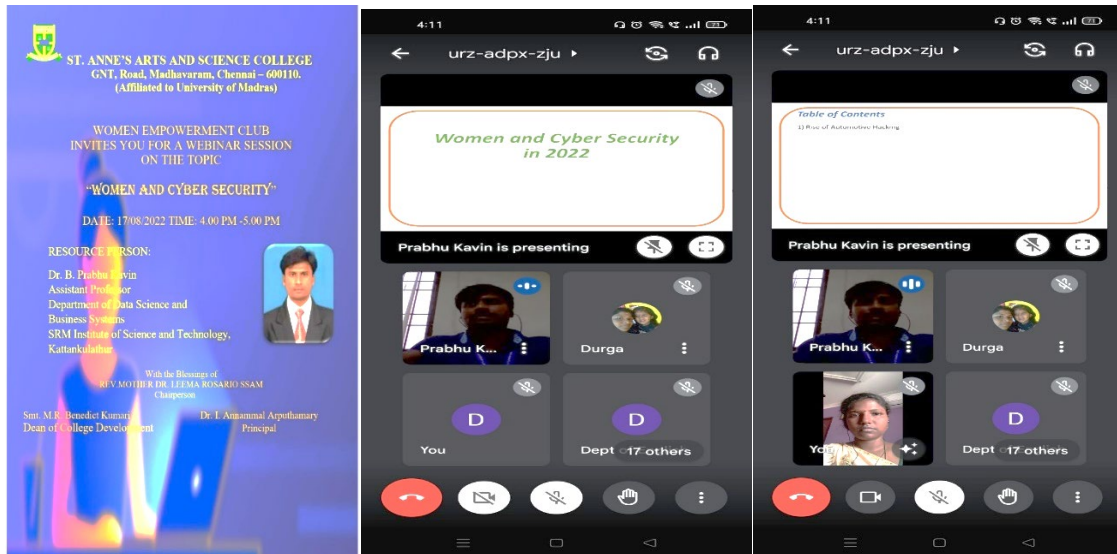

BRIDGE COURSE

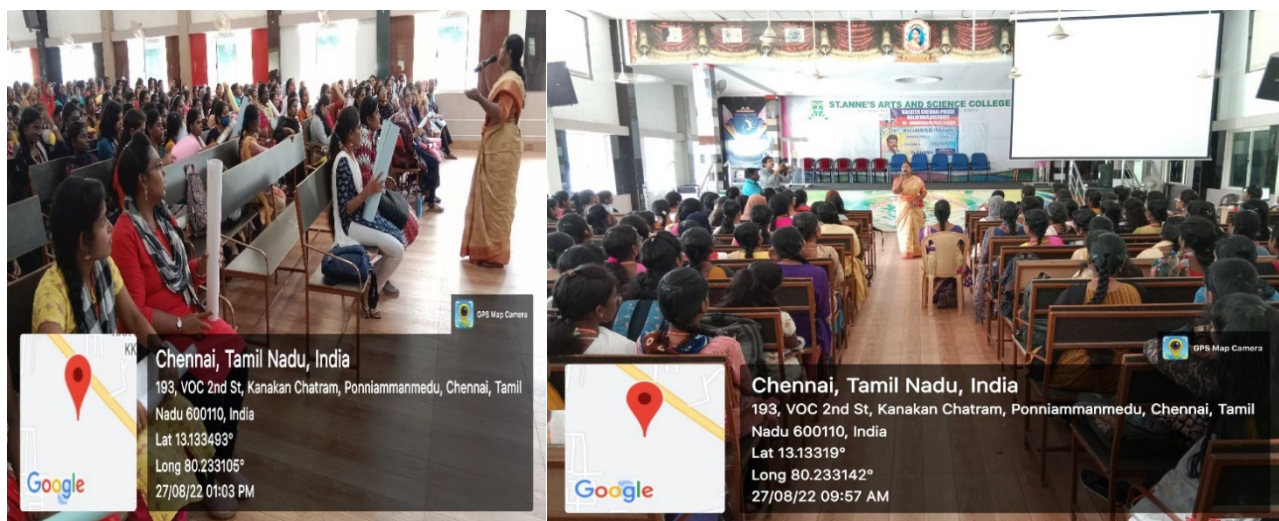

IN-HOUSE PLACEMENT TRAINING

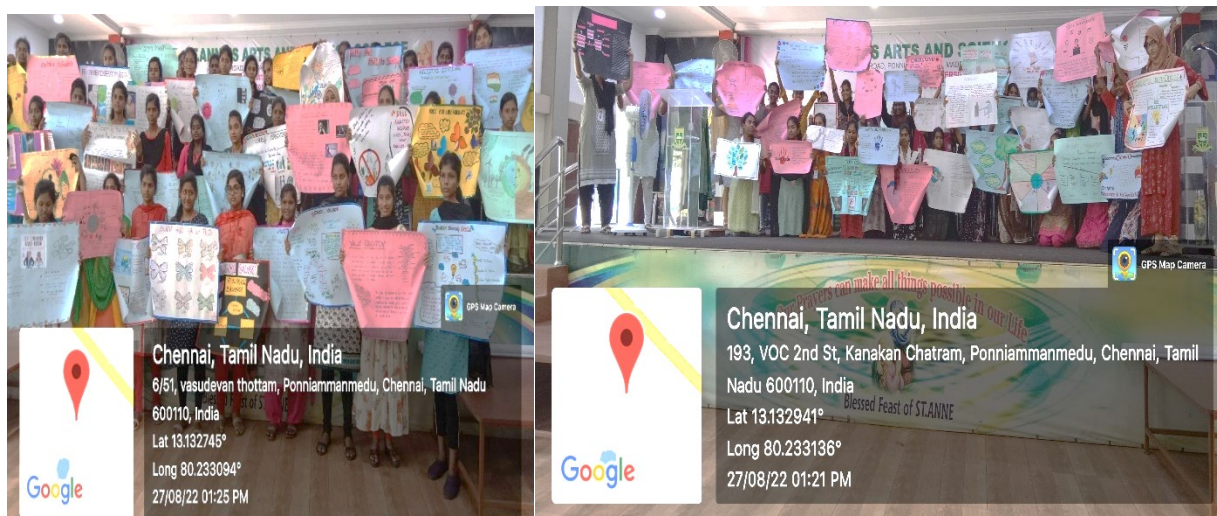

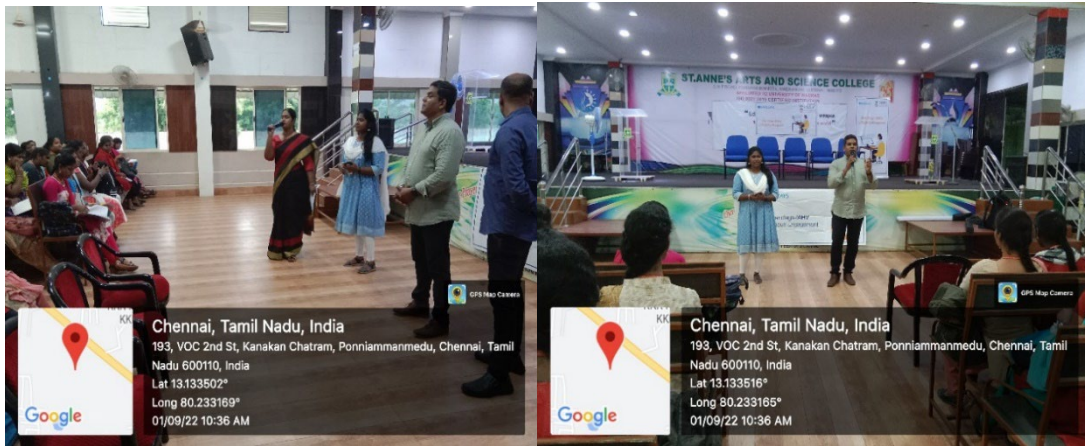


VALUE EXHIBITION

AWARD FOR WASTE MANAGEMENT FOR THE COLLEGE BY GREATER CHENNAI CORPORATION

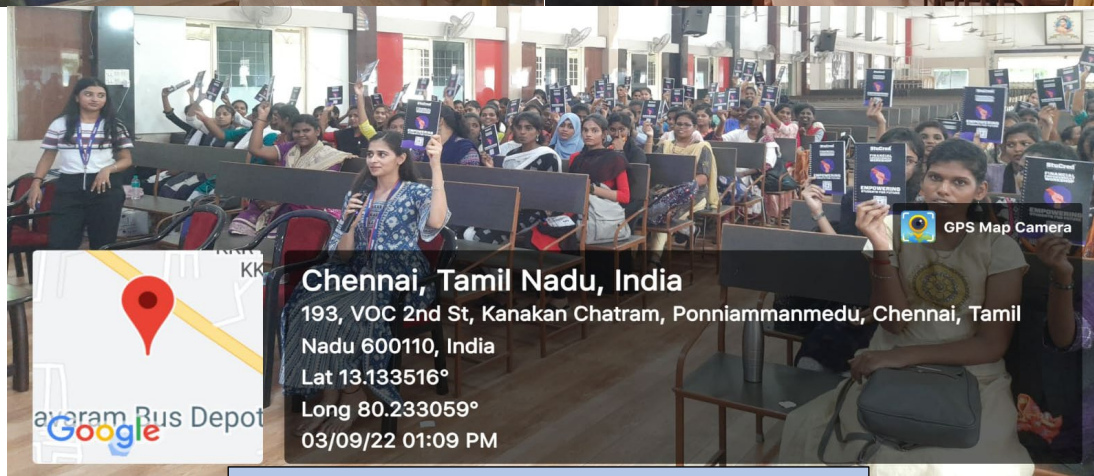

LEPROSY CASE DEDUCTION CAMP- 14 DAYS

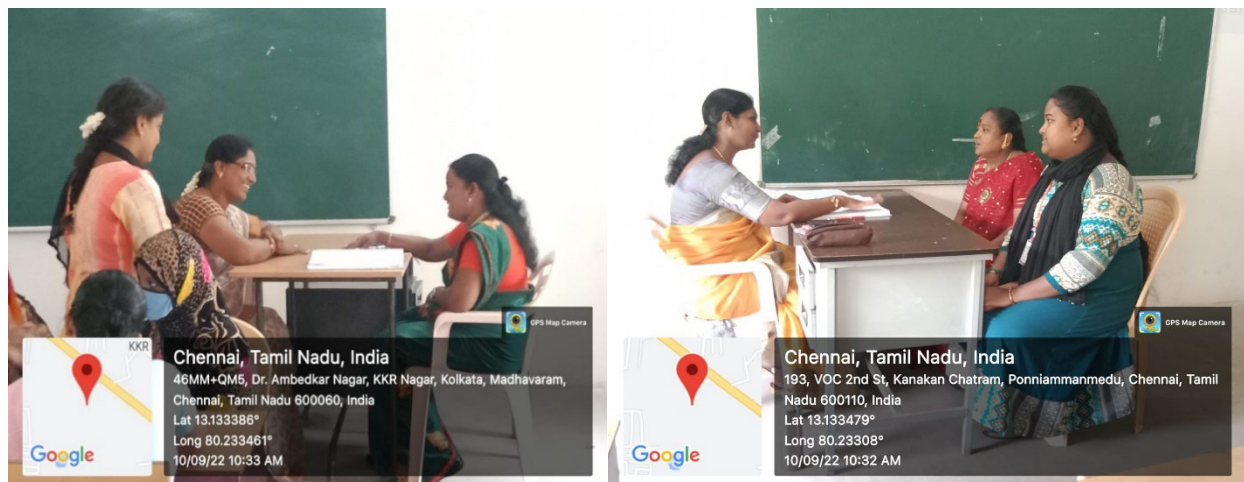
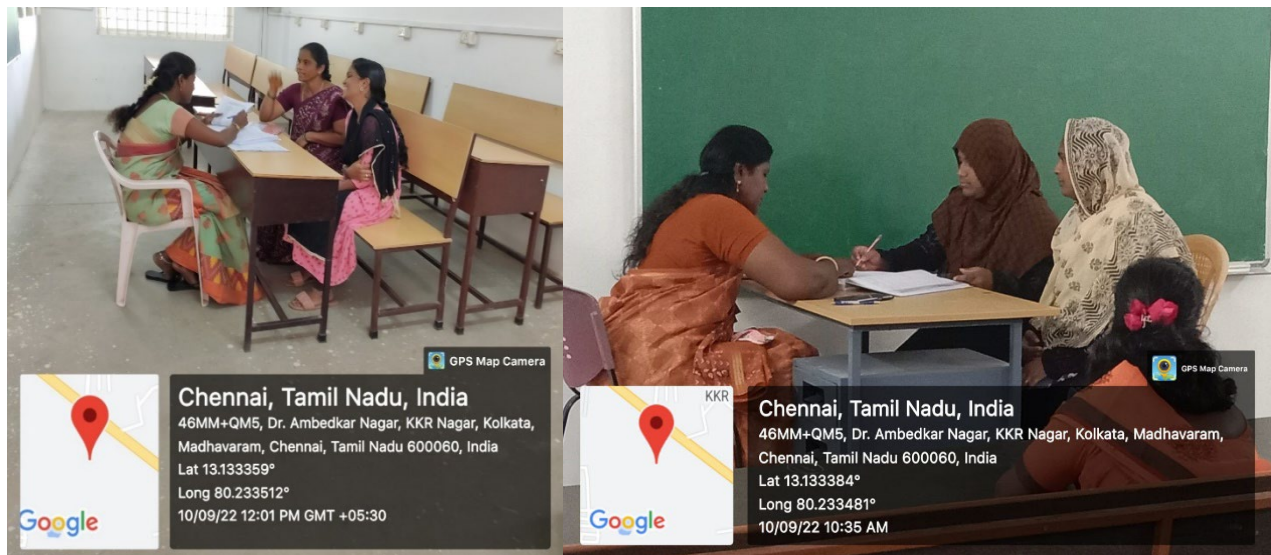

SOCIAL JUSTICE DAY

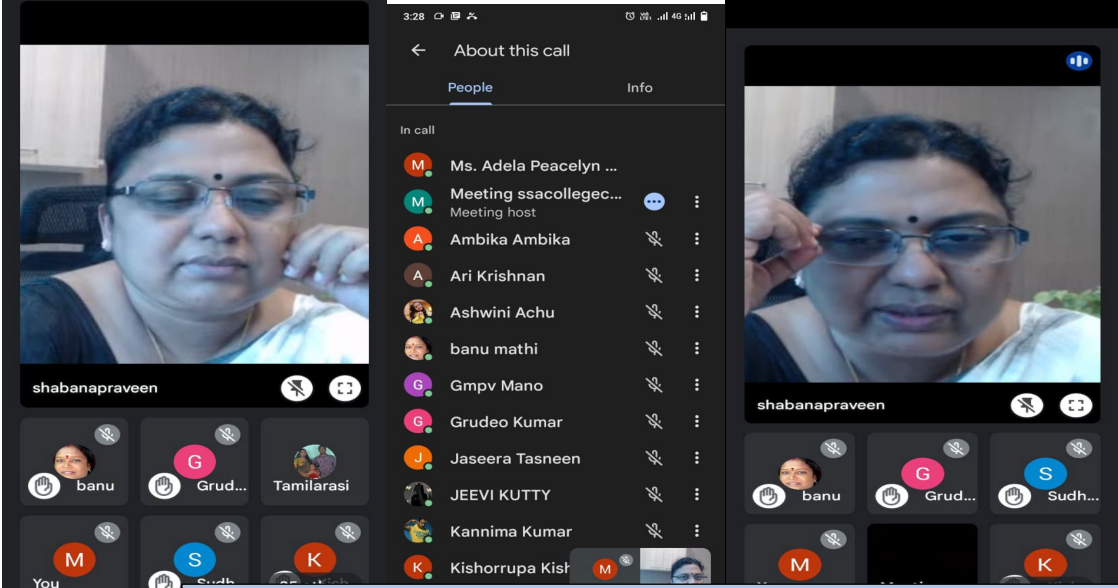

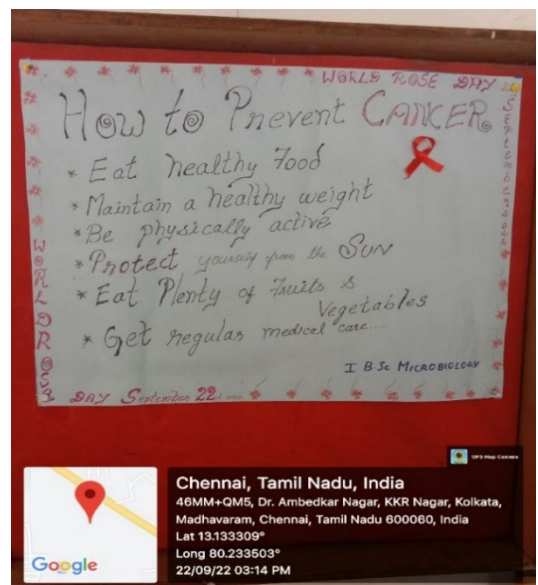

NSS - POSHAN ABHIYAAN PROGRAM

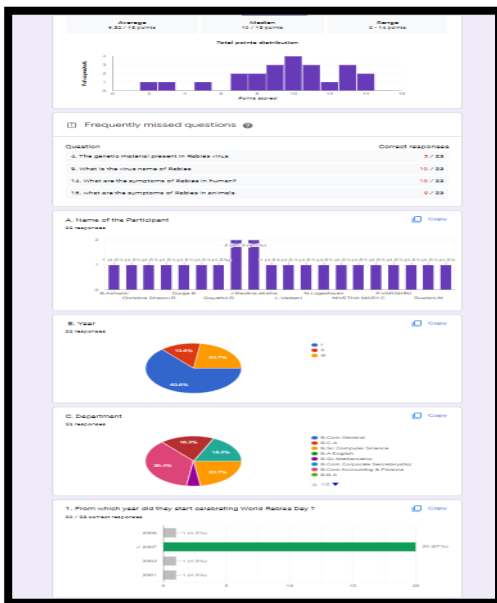

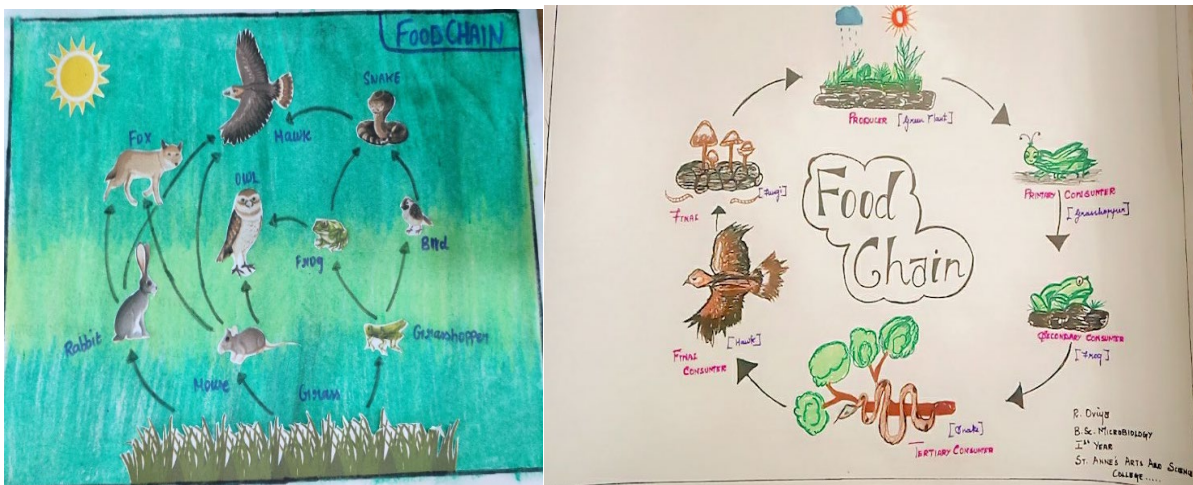

The Department of Microbiology organized a Hands on Training session on the “Handling and Maintenance of Microscope” on 06th October, 2022. The guest trainer was, Dr. K. Padmavathy Professor, Department of Microbiology, Sree Balaji Dental College and Hospital, Pallikaranai, Chennai. 34 students of the Department attended the session. The first session started with the inaugural speech about microorganisms and microscope. The speaker gave a brief introduction about Microscopes, types, its various parts, functioning and its handling.

The speaker continued the second session with a PowerPoint presentation that displayed the images of microorganisms and explained its classification based on structure, shape and size. The deliberations during open session were also informative and fruitful. In the third session, the speaker gave a practical explanation about the concept of staining technique, the necessity of staining the microorganism, different types of stains used in staining procedure and demonstrated the staining methods.

Session was concluded with hands on training on staining procedures where the students were provided with unstained microbial slides and they performed staining techniques and visualized using the microscope under the supervision of resource person. Dr. I. Annammal Arputhamary, Principal of St. Anne’s Arts and Science College graced the Valedictory session and presented a Certificate of Participation to Dr. K. Padmavathy.

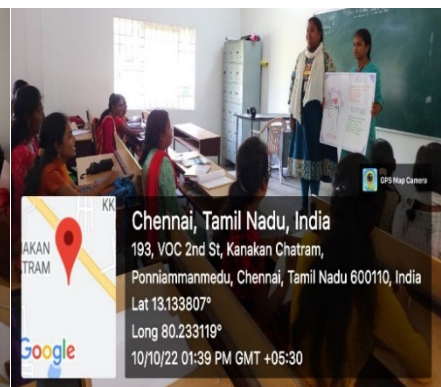
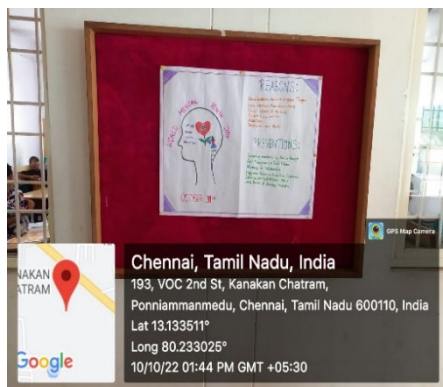

WORLD MENTAL HEALTH DAY

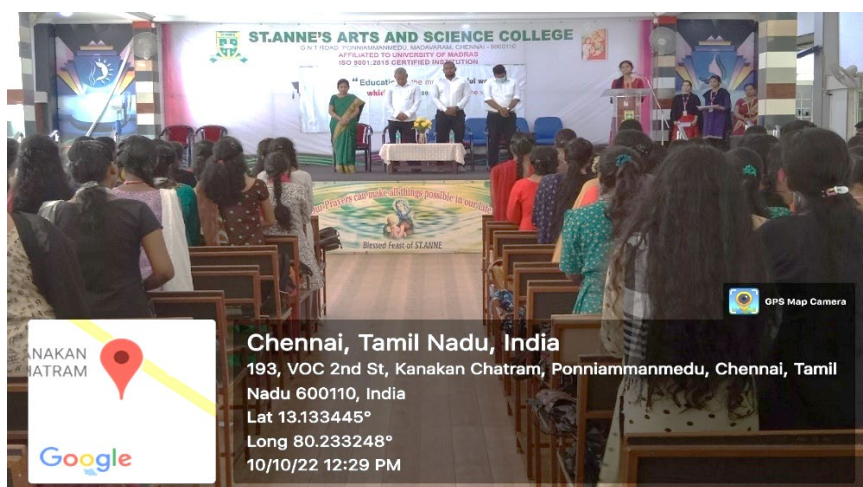

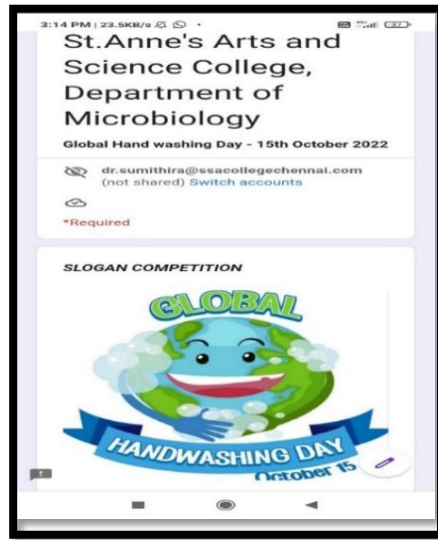


YOUTH AWAKENING DAY COMPETITIONS

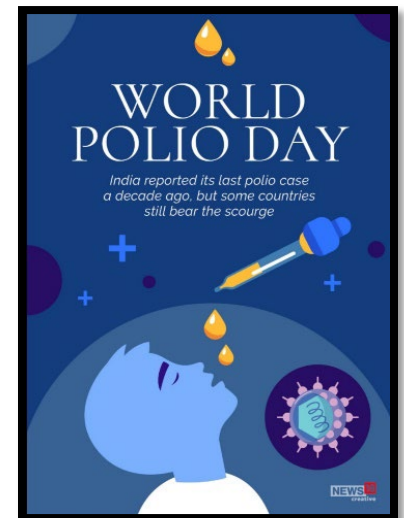

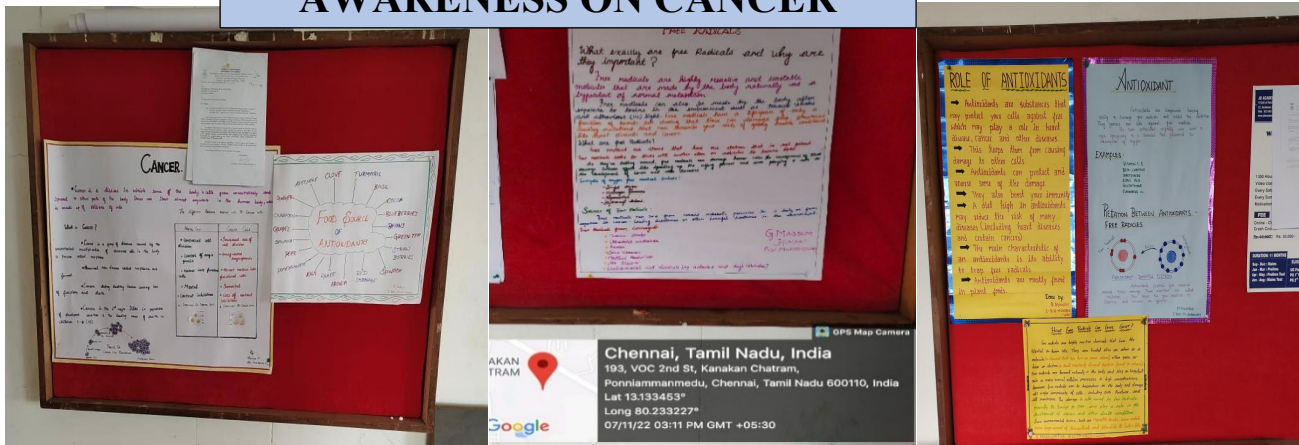
NATIONAL CANCER AWARENESS DAY

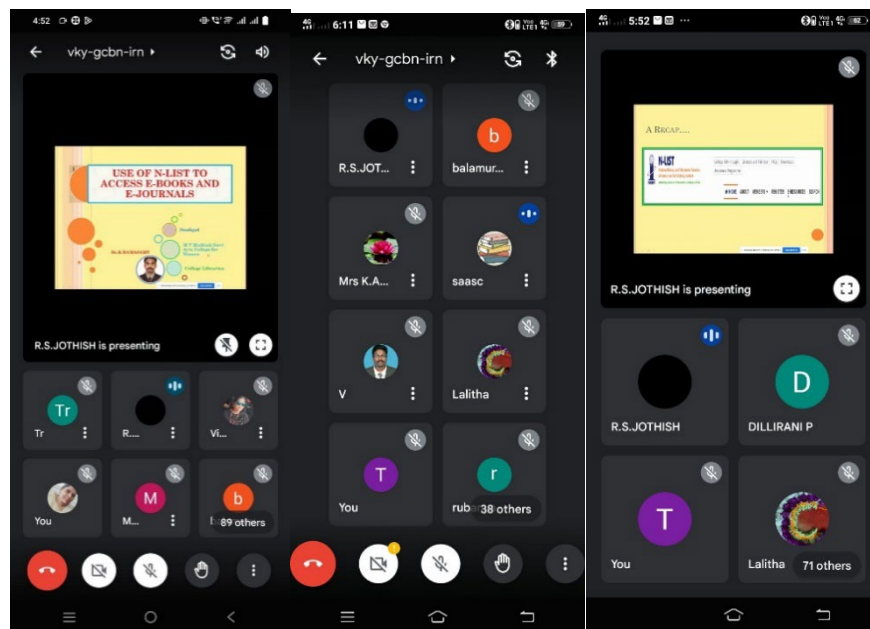

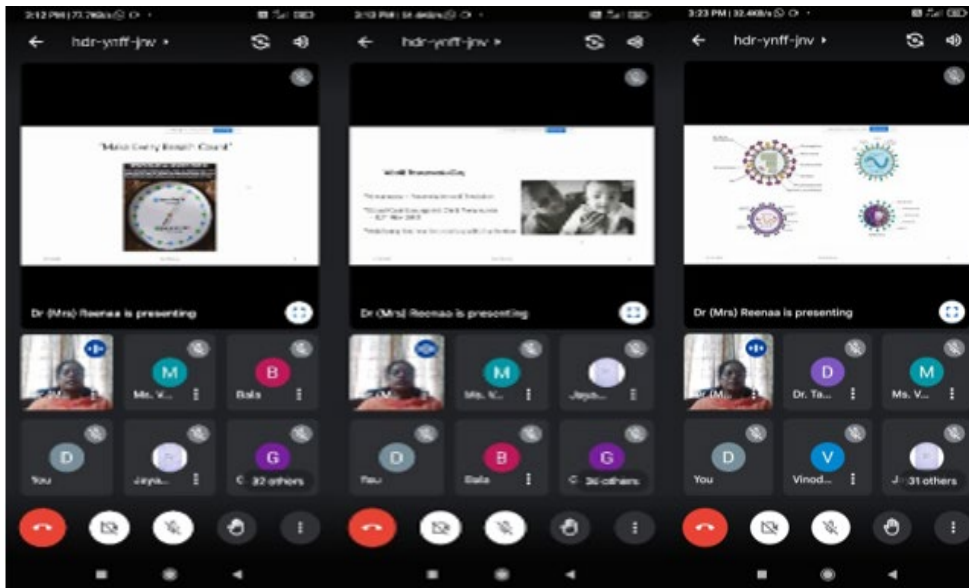
in incorporating electronic information resources and services. This session led the students and faculty members to know about the importance of research and development and inculcating the reading habits to provide improvisation of their own specific fields.

PLEDGE FOR INTERNATIONAL DAY FOR THE ELIMINATION OF VIOLENCE AGAINST WOMEN

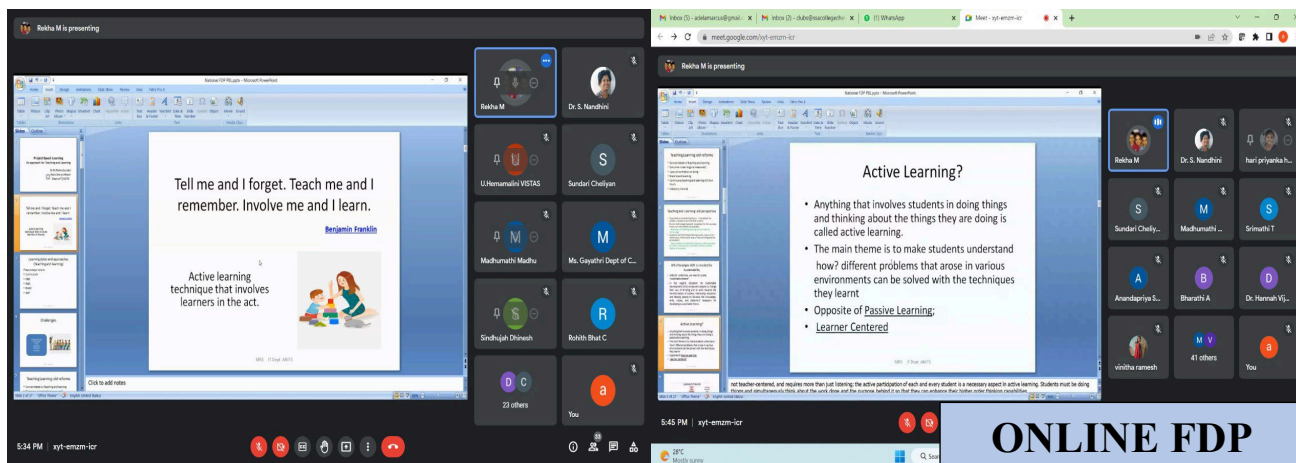

NATIONAL LEVEL ONLINE FDP ON 'RUBRICS AND PBL METHODOLOGY IN TEACHING'

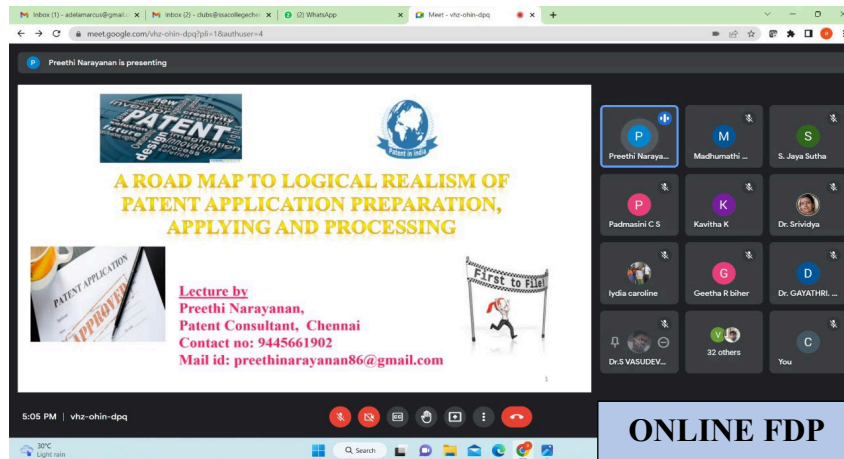

ONLINE FACULTY DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM ON 'HOW TO PATENT YOUR WORK'

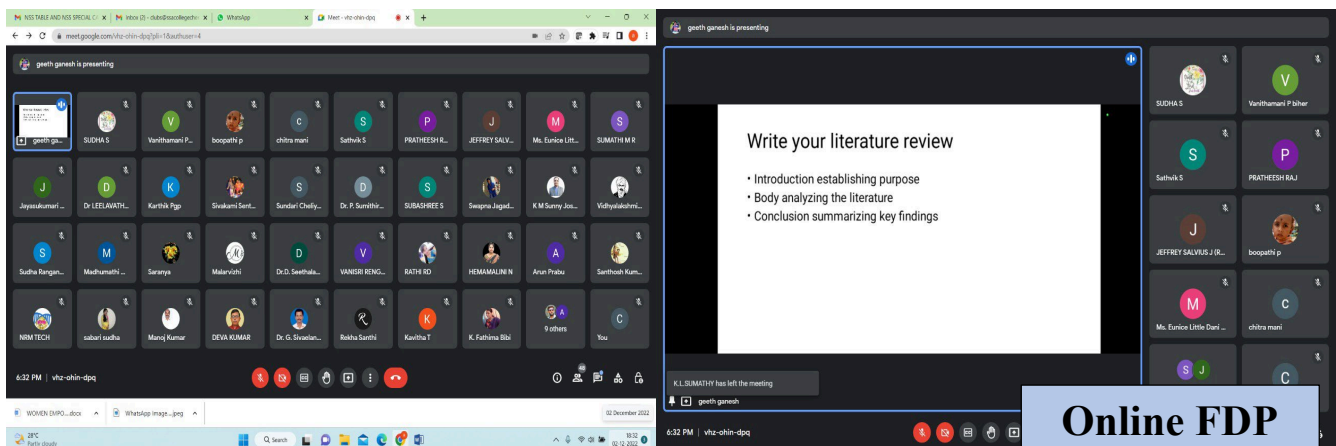

EMPLOYMENT AWARENESS INITIATIVE BY THE DISTRICT EMPLOYMENT EXCHANGE OF TAMILNADU

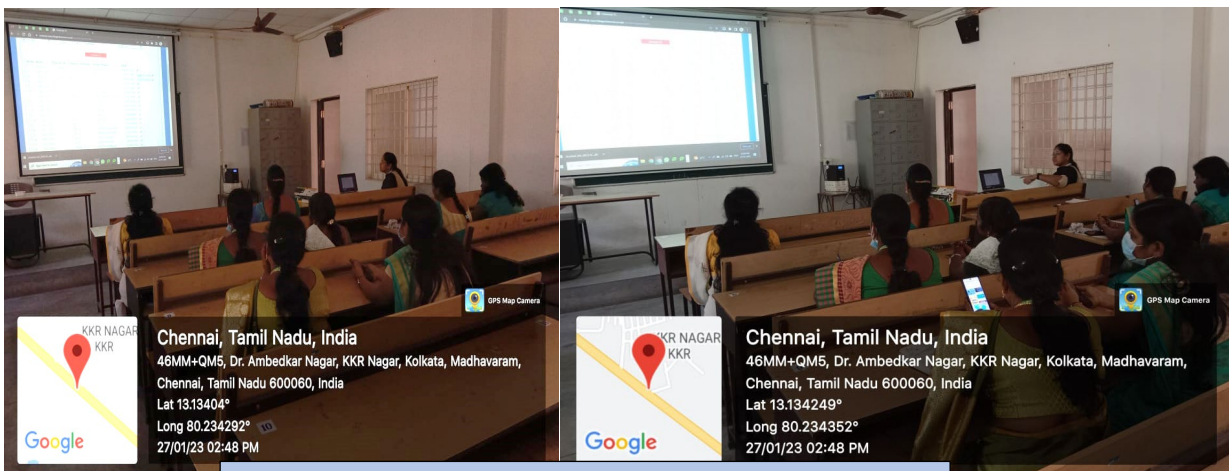

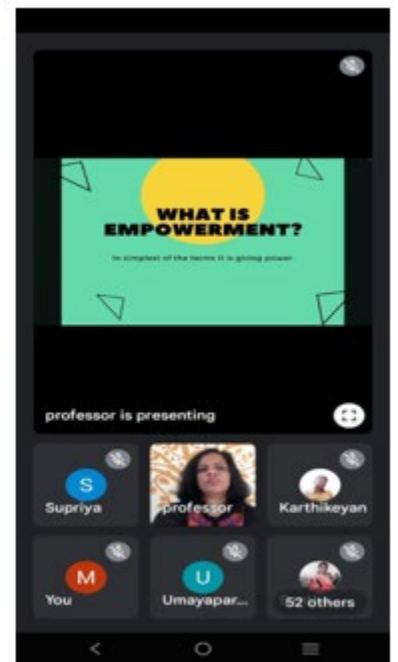
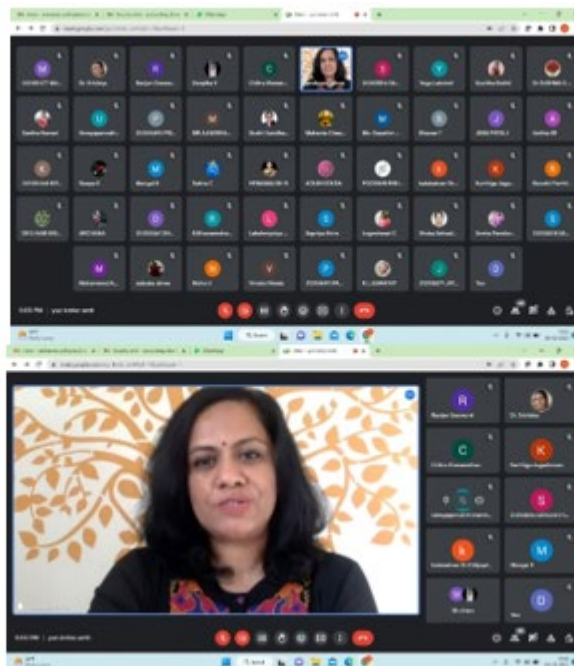
SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT

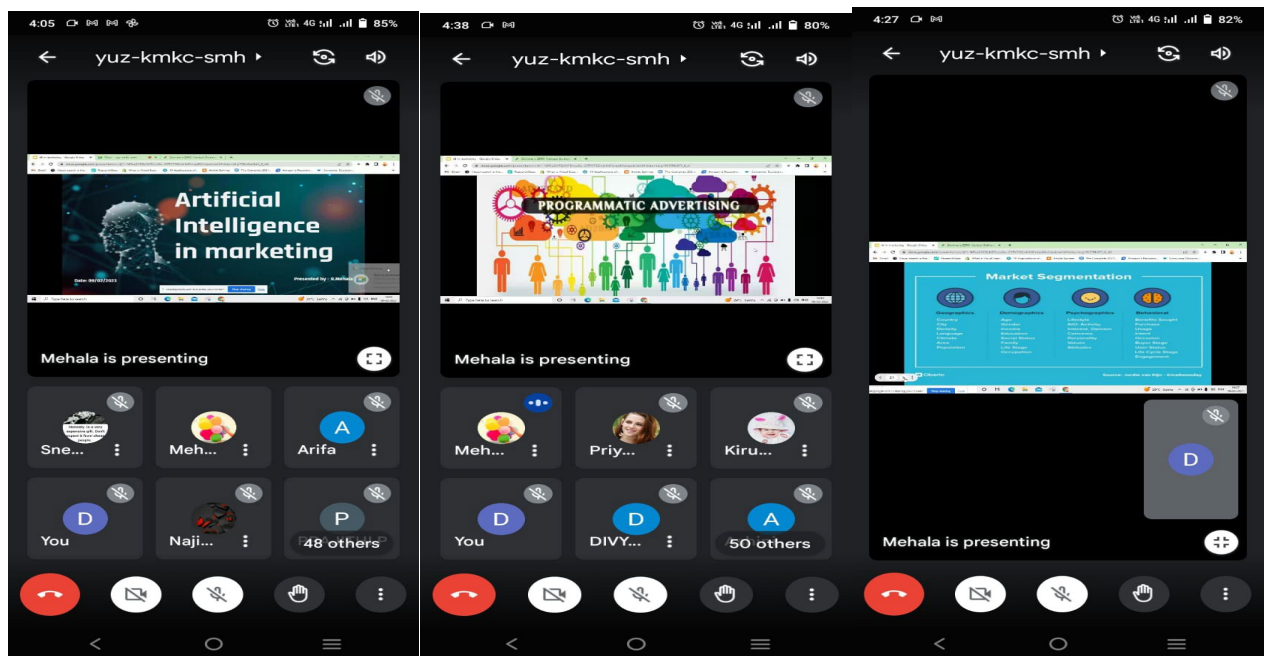


GUEST LECTURE ON SEROLOGICAL TECHNIQUES

WEBINAR ON ARTIFICIAL INTELLIGENCE AND MARKETING

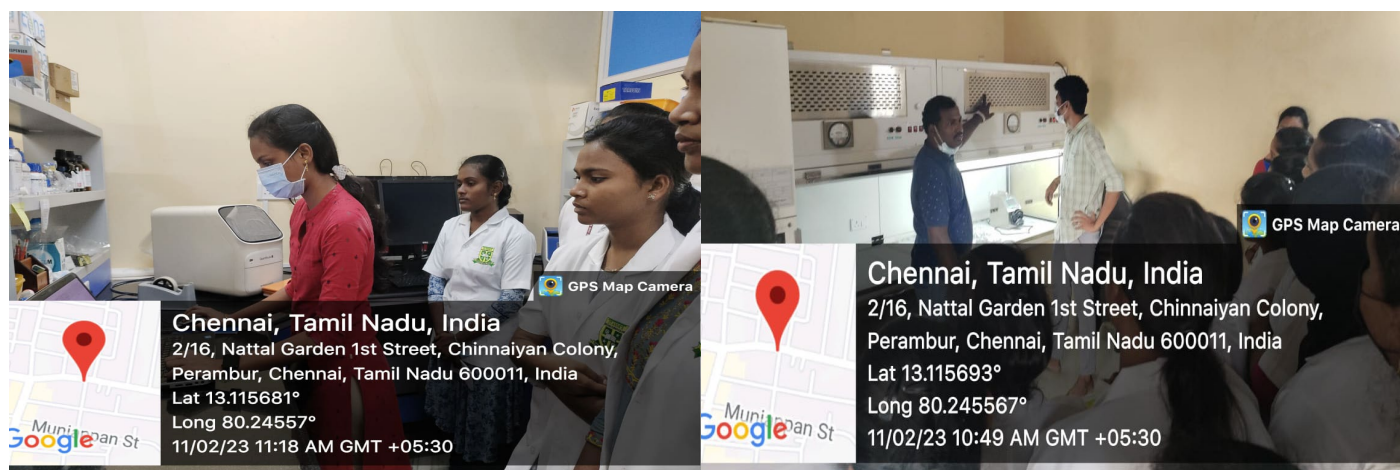

WEBINAR ON RESEARCH METHODOLOGY WITH SPSS

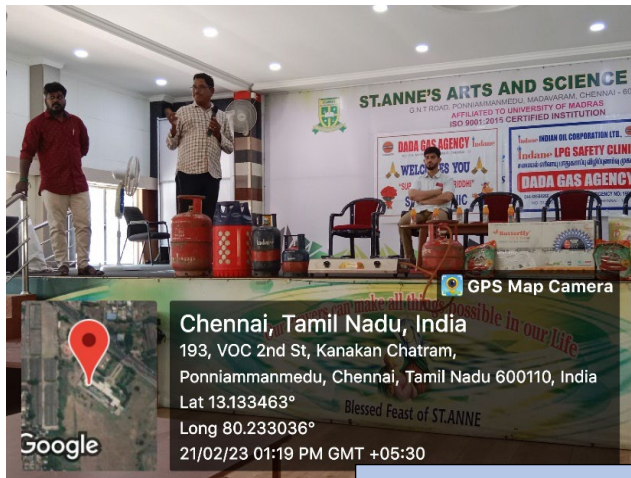

students across the departments participated in the session learnt about the safety measures of gas cylinders. At the end of the session a quiz competition was held and prizes were distributed.



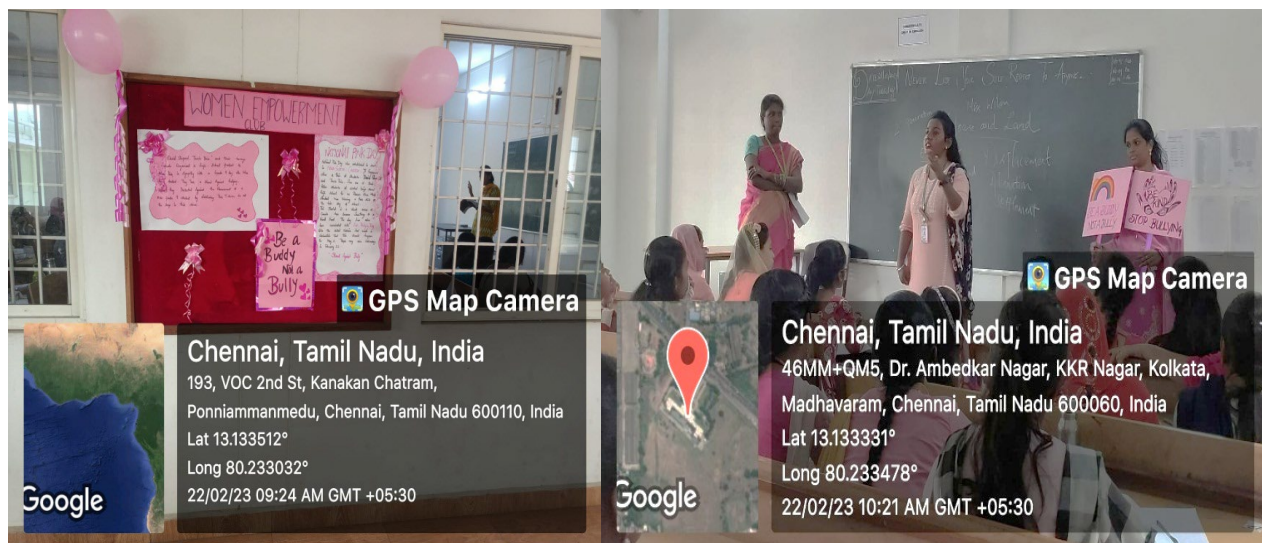

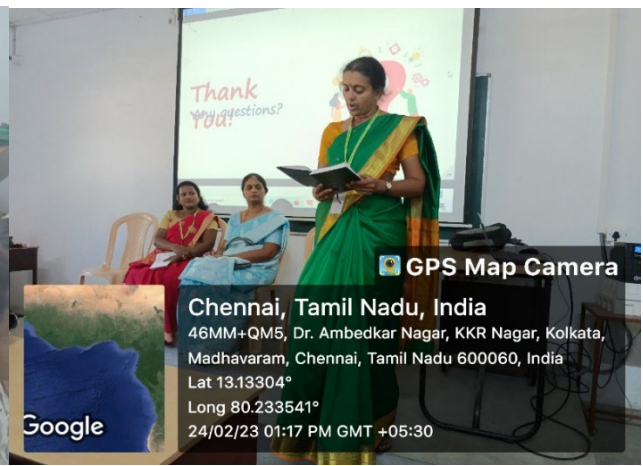
many cybercrimes happen in the web world. The awareness talk encouraged the students as they all downloaded the app in their cell phones.



SEMINAR ON DATA SCIENCE AND ANALYTICS

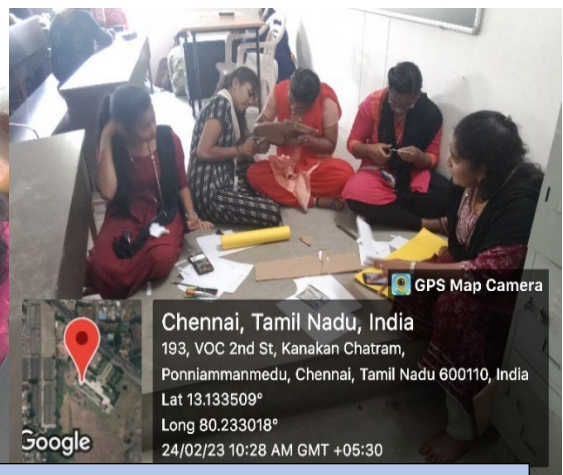

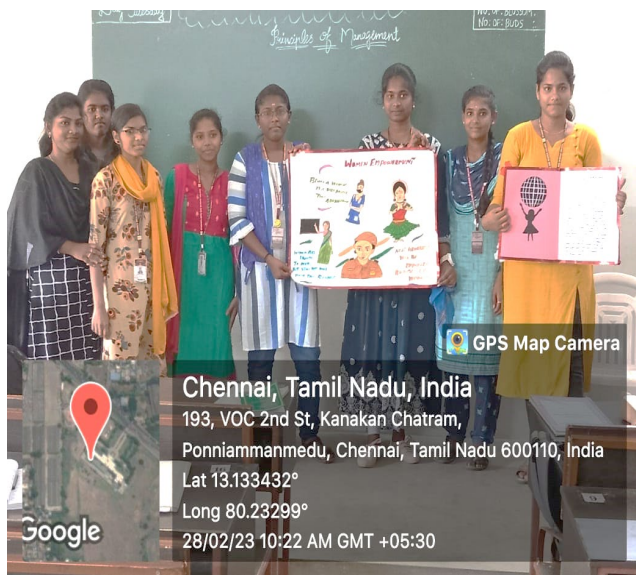


INTERCLASS COLLAGE COMPETITION

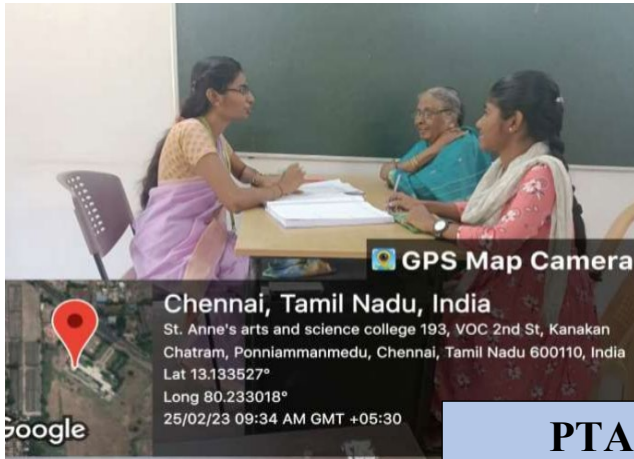
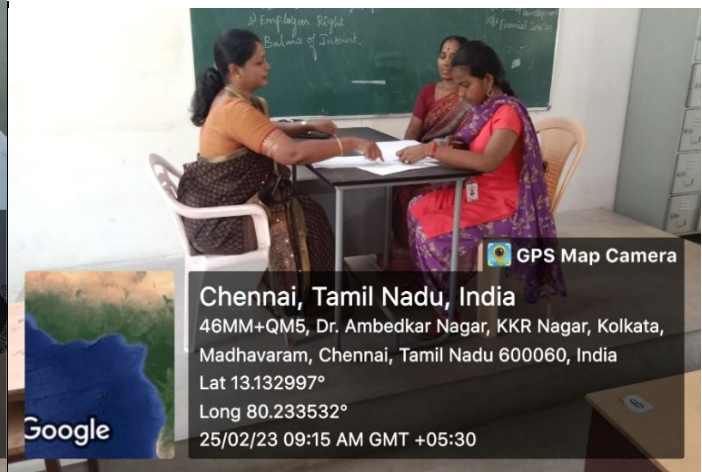

PTA MEETING – ACADEMIC YEAR 2022-2023 (EVEN SEMESTER)

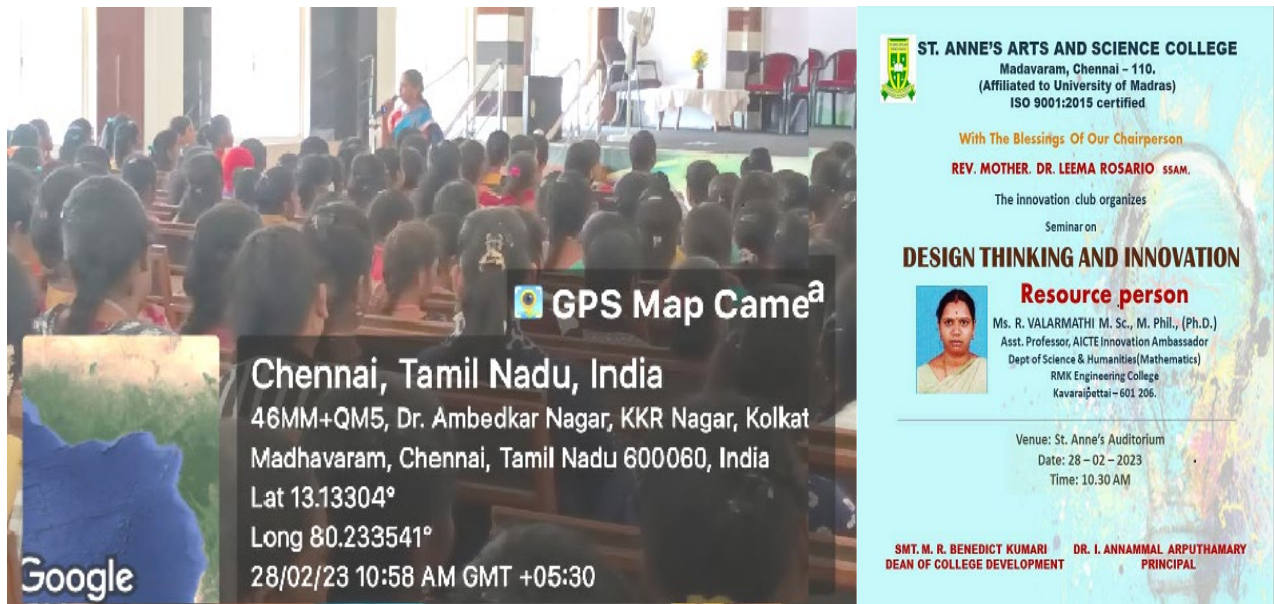

SEMINAR ON “DESIGN THINKING AND INNOVATION”

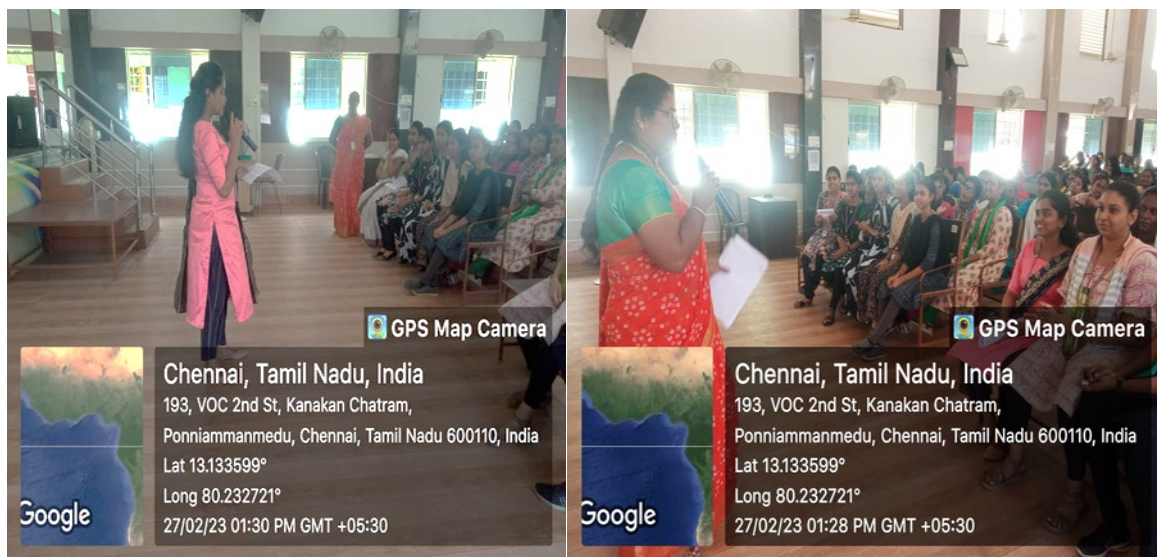

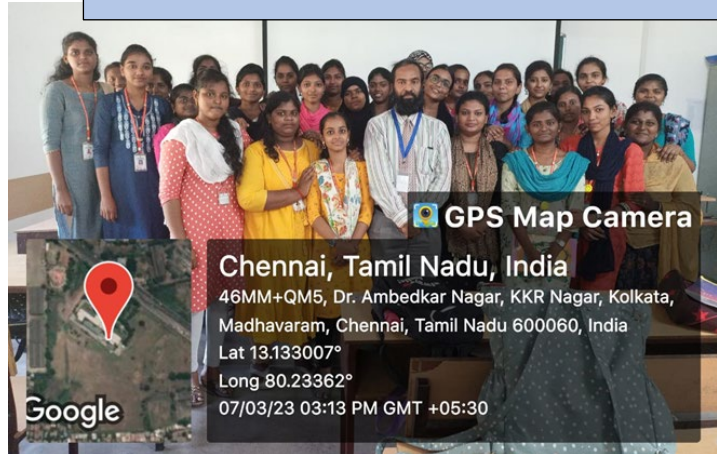

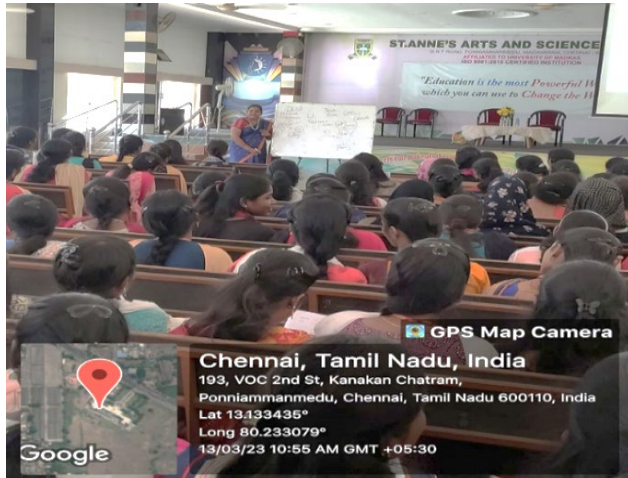


WOMEN’S DAY CELEBRATION 2023

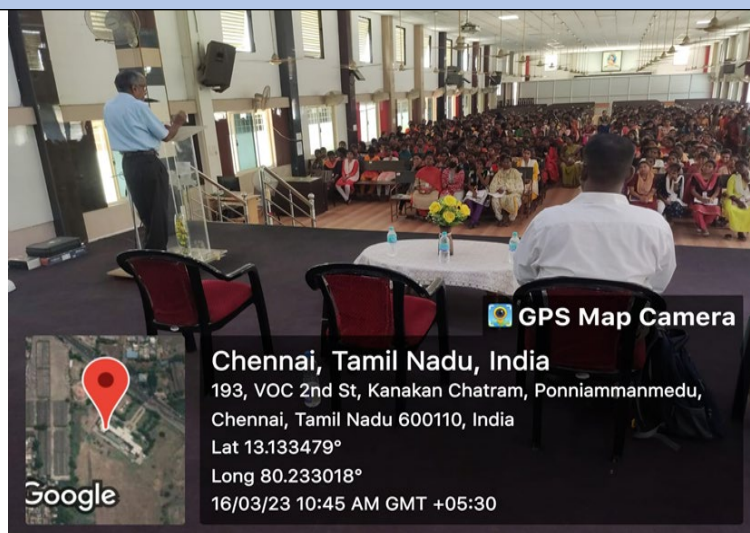
INTER-DEPARTMENTAL COMPETITION

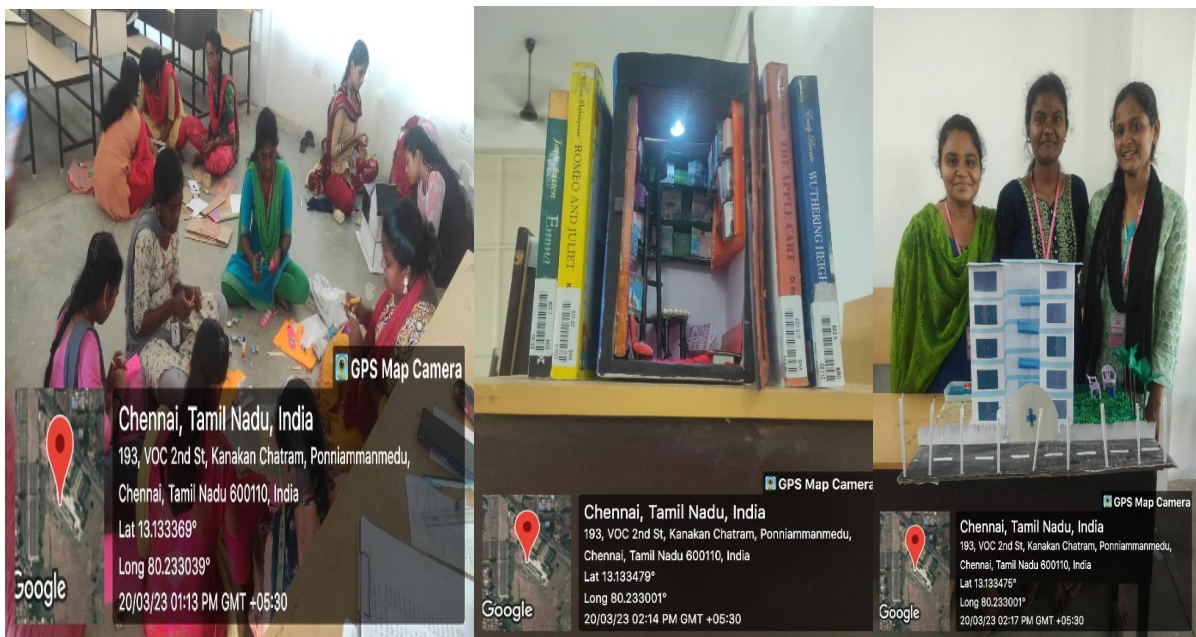
